Learning the skills of dialogue: Students learn and practise the skills of dialogue in the classroom before engaging in dialogue through videoconferences or online.

Connecting through videoconferences: We connect classrooms across the world, allowing students to explore their own views, while encountering the views of others. It is a safe space, with a trained facilitator to manage the flow of the discussion.

Connecting online: On the online community students work in small groups, with students from around the world, sharing their views and engaging in dialogue on prearranged topics.
